- Employees who have tested positive will be expected to provide the office of Human Resources with a return to work note from their physician before returning to campus.

### Close Contact

### Mask Mandates

Currently masks are required for those who have come in close contact with an infected person until day ten from exposure and those who return from isolation on days five through ten.
