Information Literacy (IL)

Bio380 and Bio490 together can fulfill one IL slot.

Quantitative Reasoning (QR)

_____ _____

Must include Math101 if the student did not test out via placement test or acceptable SAT score. Students not placing out of Math101 should consider taking the course in their first year. Math101 is a prerequisite or co-requisite for any QR designated course.

Except for Math130, transfer courses do not automatically fulfill QR (Calc, Econ, etc.). Ask advisor about possible equivalency test.

Public Presentation (PP)

_____ Any one course.

Language Proficiency

Must demonstrate proficiency equivalent to second term of any 100-level language course (e.g. Span102) *or* any 1+credit 200+ level Computer Science course.

Notes:

- Students transferring in 55+ credits need to fulfill only 2 of the 3 Moral/Civil/GCA requirements.
- Students transferring in 27+ credits need to fulfill only 15 Spiritual credits; students transferring in 55+ credits need to fulfill only 12 Spiritual credits. Religion 101 or 110 and the Rel2xx (doc) are still required.
- Pop-Up courses do not fulfill Core requirements.

Must be 4 or more credits in Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, or Physics (One of the four credits must be a lab credit and must be paired with its intended lecture.).

Civil

_____ Must be a 3+ credit course.

Moral

_____ Must be a 3+ credit course.

Global and Cultural Awareness (GCA)

Must be a 3+ credit course from the list of approved GCA courses
