What is the Cost of Attendance (COA)?

The COA is a student's estimated budget, including both direct and indirect costs.

Students are billed for direct costs only.

Indirect costs are allowable expenses that a student may incur with amounts varying among students.

A student's total amount of financial aid from all resources may not exceed their COA.

If a student incurs an unusual expense that may affect their standard COA that meets the definition as defined by the Department of Education the Financial Aid Office has the authority on a student case by case basis to adjust the student's COA to include the expense.
