Advice for tracking through the major

Courses *required* in a particular year

First year:

- Writing 101 (Core)
- Two religion courses (Residency)

Second year:

- Writing 202 (Core)
- Two religion courses (Residency)

Third year:

- One religion course (Residency)

Fourth year:

- HSoc 401 (major)
- HSoc 402 (major)
- One religion course (Residency)

Courses *recommended* in particular years:

In the first or second years:

- Three of the following: Anthropology 110, Geography 110, History 1xx, Political Science 101, Sociology 110 (major)
- Math 102: Understanding Mathematics in Society
- Begin the Language/Math/Computer Science requirement (Core)

Third year:

- At least two 300-level courses from the perspectives (major)
