Room Selection 2019 Information

Housing Agreement Notice

Bryn Athyn now has a one-year housing agreement. Therefore, students who participate in room selection will be obligated to stay/pay for the Residence Halls for the entire academic year or whatever portion they remain eligible for campus housing. A copy of the Housing Agreement will be provided to students to fill out prior to Room Selection.

Eligibility

All students registered full time for the Fall 2019 academic term are eligible for Room Selection. Commuter students are welcome to apply for housing by paying a Room Deposit by March 8, 2019 by 5:00pm.

Students who are planning to change their resident status must communicate this to the Office of Residence Life by **Friday, March 8th, 2019 at 5:00pm.**

Room Selection Event

The Room Selection will take place in the **Pendleton Auditorium** on **Friday March 15, 2019 from 1:00pm to approximately 4:00pm or until completion.** Students are expected to arrive 15 minutes early and remain until their number is called (times are approximate).

- 1:00pm Numbers 1 – 35
- 1:30pm Numbers 36 – 100
- 2:00pm Numbers 101 and plus

Required Items

You are required to bring **Housing Agreement, your lottery card and student ID.** ***You will not be permitted to select a room without these items.***

IMPORTANT: Bryn Athyn College reserves the right to change room selections as a result in changes in enrollment and facilities issues.

Lottery Numbers

- All students eligible for housing and planning to live on campus will be assigned a lottery number. These numbers are generated by number of credits completed. The numbers are assigned lowest to highest, therefore students with a high number of credits toward their bachelor's degree will be given low numbers.

- You will receive your lottery number card in your campus mailbox on Monday March 11th by 5:00pm.
- Points for attending information sessions: These sessions are optional, however each person who attends one information session will receive 5 “bonus points” added to their number of credits (higher chance for lower number).
 - The information sessions are identical, and students only need to attend one to receive their 5 bonus points.
 - Students will not receive more than 5 bonus points for attending more than one session.

Selecting Roommates/Suitemates/Floormates

- Each student is assigned one lottery number and can select up to four other students to also use their number, and to live in the same space.
 - Roommate(s) must be listed in the space provided on the “best” lottery card for the agreement to be honored.
 - All members of a group requesting to be together should be present when the best lottery number is called or have their proxy form with the group leader.
- Group selections are made either in one suite. Suites have five spaces (two doubles and one single).
 - However, if one room is already taken on a floor you may only select the rest of the rooms available on that floor.
- If you are hoping to select a single room and have no preferences about who lives in your suite or on your floor, please check to see if you have a competitive lottery number. You will need an alternate plan if your lottery number is high.

Room Selection Day

- Lottery numbers will be called beginning with number one. When your number is called, you will be ushered into the selection area. Present your lottery card, student ID and housing agreement. After you have made your selection, the residence life staff will reserve the space for you. You will also be asked to sign your housing contract at this time.
- Around June 11th, you will receive a confirmation via campus email about your housing assignment for the academic year. All spaces are impacted by enrollment and Bryn Athyn College reserves the right to change the assignments based on need.

*Cooper/Goodenough Halls will only be opened for selection when all other spaces are filled.

Selection by Proxy

- Students are expected to make every effort to be at Room Selection, however if you are unable to attend, a friend may represent your housing interests via a Proxy Form. Proxy Forms will can be obtained via the Residence Life website (www.brynthyn.edu/student-life/residence-life)
- The proxy form must be presented by the person selecting for you on the date of Room Selection along with *your* lottery card, and *your* housing agreement.

Room Changes

- To request a room change after the Room Selection, you may request in writing to the Director of Residence Life.
- **Room changes are not guaranteed.** They will depend on availability.
- Summer room changes are considered between June 12th and August 1st, 2019. You will be notified via campus email if the room change has been approved, or if Residence Life requires more information from you.
- Room changes are not permitted during Room Selection or between the date of Room Selection and June 11th. Speak with the Director of Residence Life if you have concerns about who you will be living with.
