- C- or better in Math130, Math140 or Math150 (or AP equivalent)
- C- or better in Phil101 (or approval by department)

Building Arts BFA (Stephen Hartley):

- A grade a C- or better in FA101 or 201, FA141, and a studio arts course
- Minimum overall GPA of 2.00

Education Major (Sarah Wong):

- Minimum overall GPA of at least 2.8
- Completed at least
 - 48 credits of college-level coursework
 - six credits in college-level mathematics
 - three credits in college-level English composition
 - three credits in literature
- Fulfilled the Basic Skills requirement as specified by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (see BAC website for details)

English Language and Literature Major (Kristin King):

- Minimum overall GPA of 2.5
- Minimum GPA of 2.7 in English and writing courses
