## Policy on Accommodations of Learning Disabilities Office of Student Support Services

Bryn Athyn College makes every effort, within its resources, to provide equal opportunities to students with documented learning disabilities. We promote self-disclosure and self advocacy for students with disabilities. Students seeking accommodations in the classroom must contact the dean of academics before entering any course or program in which accommodations may be necessary.

All information (e.g. IEP,ILP, medical records, etc.) about a student's disability must come from that student or with voluntary, written authorization from that student. It is the student's responsibility to share that information with any faculty or staff member who may need to know. The head of student support services will help facilitate these conversations.

For students with documented learning disabilities the College accommodates on a case by case basis. As a small college our services have limitations but we make every effort to ensure reasonable accommodations which may involve some curricular modification but will not alter the course content or waive requirements essential to the academic program. Some examples of reasonable accommodations are:

- Extended time on tests
- Use of auxiliary equipment such as tape recorders, computers, calculators
- Modified examination formats and or oral examination ( does not apply to written assessment of writing skills)
