

Art History Minor at Bryn Athyn College

The minor in Art History is completed with 15 credits (five courses) of Art History and 3 credits (one course) of additional coursework in *either* Art History *or* a Studio Art in the Fine Arts Department.

Students must earn a grade above C- in all courses counting toward the minor and maintain an average of 2.0 in their Art History and Studio Art classes.

No more than six credits of coursework toward the minor may overlap with coursework that counts also toward a student's major.
